Hello and welcome back to a new term. I hope you are all feeling well rested after the two weeks off and are raring to go with excitement for all the learning we are going to do this term.

Topics

Our Topics this term are 'All settlements are the same?' which is a geography topic. In this topic we will be learning about our local area, using OS maps and will carry out some fieldwork in the local surroundings. We will then compare our findings with the location of New Delhi, identifying human and physical features.

We will also learn about 'How hard was it to invade and settle in Britain?' which is a history topic. In this topic we will be learning about how the Britons felt when the Romans left Britain, the reasons for the Anglo-Saxon invasion and the different Anglo-Saxon settlements and beliefs. We will also be going on a school trip to West Stow to explore the different Anglo-Saxon buildings and to look at different artefacts.

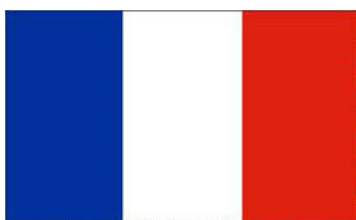
Maths

French

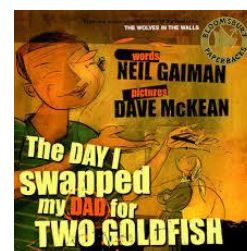
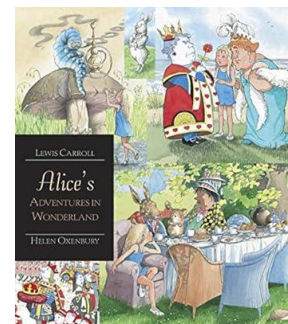
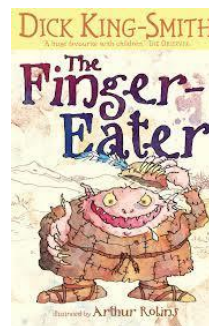

Computing
